As Red Betty moves into its second decade and the next phase of its growth, we look ahead to projects such as a full-length production of **Blackberry**, fostering new playwrights through the annual **Decolonise Your Ears New Play Festival**, and the post production and release of our **10th Anniversary Podcast Series**.
